# Happy New Year from Your Treasurer By Randi Neff

Thank you all for being patient with me this year, especially around Christmas. Jeff and I took a leave of absence from the country for the Caribbean, and I probably forgot a lot of things. I'm back to being focused on St. David's, however. I wanted to give you an update on our budget timeline. Our annual meeting is scheduled for January 28<sup>th</sup> after the service. We will present our budget which vestry should be able to approve at our regular meeting on January 14<sup>th</sup>. I will be sending out your annual 2023 pledge statements next week.

To meet this timeline, we need to be sure all pledges have been recorded. We have 28 pledges totaling \$99,806 with a goal of \$113,000. In 2023 we collected \$30,000 more than was pledged. Part of that was fundraising, but over \$5,000 was collected in cash offerings. The pledge amount helps us set our budget, but we cannot include estimated cash offerings. We are doing fine financially, but it makes it difficult to set a reasonable budget if pledges are not made.


