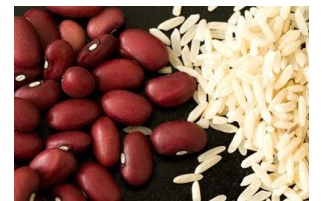
Mind the White Board

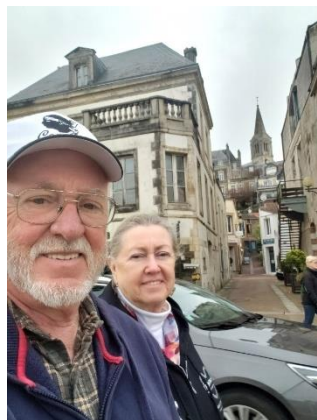
