St. David's cemetery consists of full burial plots (34) containing coffin burials, and two existing spaces for interment of cremains. There are 7 existing cremains plots to the right of the walkway (facing the church) with possible room for three additional spaces.

In 2017-18 an undeveloped portion of the cemetery (now enclosed by the rock wall) was developed for 20 cremains spaces each measuring 36" by 30", with a nice level area above for the conduct of interment services. There was a substantial cost involved in the creation of that area, and for that reason spaces were made available at a cost of \$400 each. Of the 20 spaces in this area, 12 have been purchased and 8 remain available. Beginning discussions are underway for the additional development of cremains spaces immediately below (to the street side) of the stone wall area.

With much assistance from the vestry liaison to the cemetery committee, Brad Orvis, some safety improvements have been completed on the stepped walkway. Brad has already completed some necessary work to level some of the uneven stone steps.
