Dear Friends,

I am writing to provide you with an update on our budgeting process.

Our recent Stewardship Campaign concluded successfully with broad participation from parishioners. However, we did fall short in that our total pledges were about 9% less than projected expenses for the upcoming year. After making considerable cuts where possible and planning for fundraising, it is nonetheless necessary to come back to the revenue side of the budget and consider how we might cover the shortfall.

Earlier this week, we emailed pledging members to ask them to consider an increase in their pledge, along with some numbers to help put the "ask" in context. (Missed it? Read it here.)

Each one of us will have our own calculation and process of discernment, but we are all asked to make a pledge, or to consider increasing our pledge if we can.
