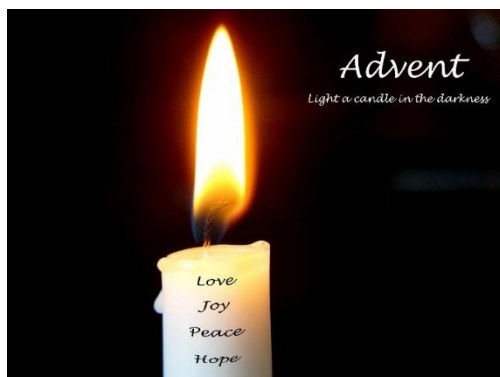

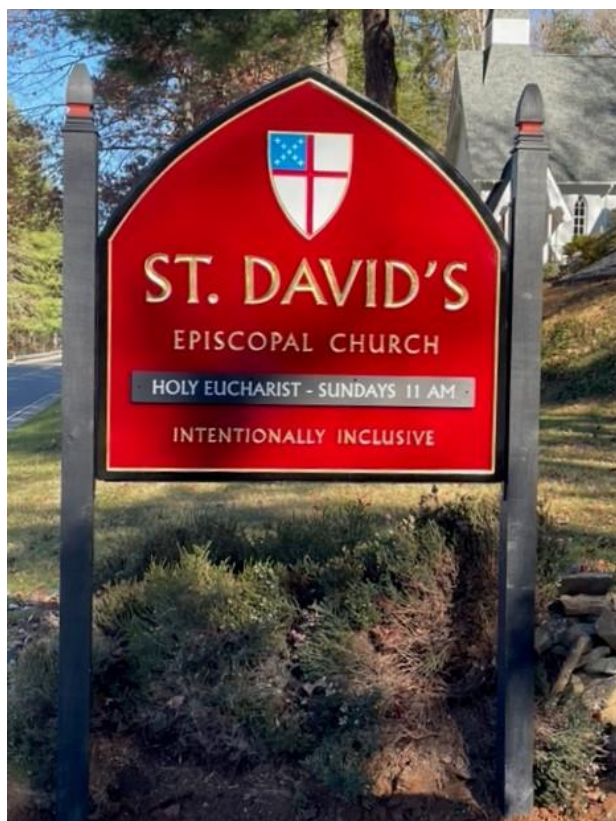

Operation Christmas Box 2022

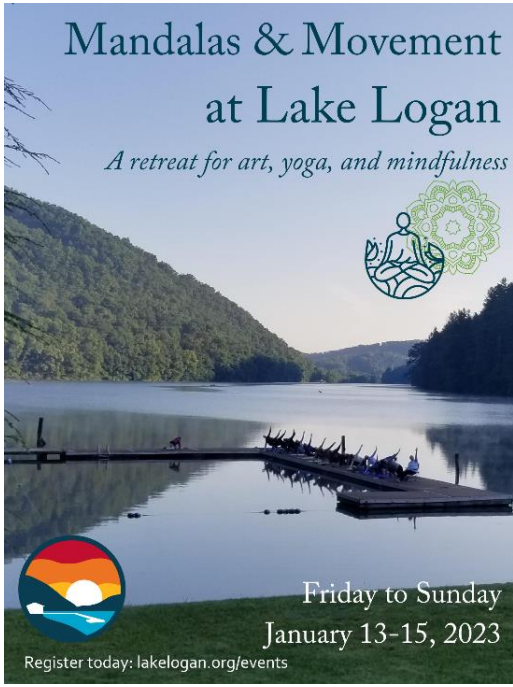
