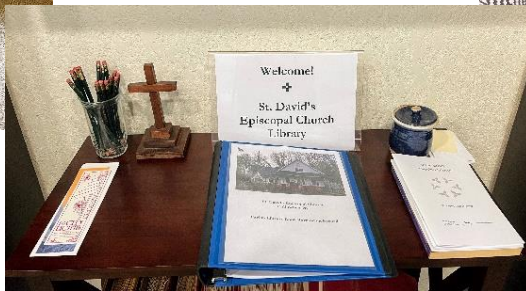
## Announcing St. David's Lending Library
